LET US HELP YOU BUDGET!

Would you like to know exactly what your natural gas bill will be each month, even before it arrives? What if you could pay the same monthly amount on your natural gas bill year-round, much like your car payment or mortgage? At Wyoming Gas Company, we can help you do that with our Budget Payment Plan.

Here's how it works; we add up your natural gas bills for one year and then divide that amount by 12. This amount becomes your monthly payment each month, every month, with no fluctuation. Then, each October, we recalculate your budget payment amount based on your actual usage, taking into account any outstanding balance or credit, and send you a letter with your new budget amount for the next 12 months. That amount is "locked in" for a full year. You will still receive monthly statements from Wyoming Gas showing your actual usage and your account balance.

Use the form at the bottom of this page to sign up for our Budget Payment Plan. Simply check YES when you fill out the form and mail it back to us or bring it into our office.

Note: To enroll in the Budget Payment Plan, your account must be at a zero balance, and you must have at least 12 months of billing history at your service location.

Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP)

LIEAP (Low Income Energy Assistance Program) is a federally funded program that will help people pay heating bills during the winter heating season. The program is open to homeowners and renters. It helps cover the cost of electricity, natural gas, propane, wood, diesel heating oil, coal and pellets when these are used for heating a home.

If you or someone you know needs assistance with heating bills this winter, please contact the Department of Family Services (DFS) at 800-457-3659 or Wyoming LIEAP at 800-246-4221 to get more information. Applications are accepted from October 1, 2025 through April 30, 2026. Weatherization applications are accepted year round.

RECIPE: Dark Chocolate Zucchini Sheet Cake

Ingredients:

- ½ cup butter
- ½ cup applesauce
- 1 ¼ cups sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 2 eggs
- ½ cup plain yogurt
- 2 ½ cups flour
- ¾ cup cocoa powder
- 3 cups shredded zucchini, undrained



Directions:

1. Preheat your gas oven to 325 degrees and spray a 9x13 pan with cooking spray.
2. In a mixing bowl, beat together butter, sugar, applesauce, and vanilla until smooth.
3. Beat in eggs one at a time.
4. In another bowl, mix together the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and cocoa.
5. Add the mixed dry ingredients and yogurt to the wet mixture. Stir in zucchini.
6. Pour batter into the cake pan and bake for 30-45 minutes or until knife inserted into the center of the cake comes out clean.
