BEWARE OF ENERGY SCAMS

Utility companies across the country are warning customers to stay alert in order to avoid costly energy scams. Reports of scam calls, utility employee impersonation, and phony disconnection threats are on the rise.

How to IDENTIFY a scam:

- Scammers use urgency, often requiring immediate payment to avoid disconnect.
- Sometimes unconventional and untraceable payment methods are requested, such as gift cards, prepaid debit cards, or cryptocurrency.
- Scams received via email often contain misspelled words and are sent from an unfamiliar domain that is different from your utility company's website.

How to AVOID a scam:

- ✓ Never give your payment information to someone who has called you. Always hang up, look up the company's actual phone number, and call the company directly to inquire about your account status.
- ✓ Never use an untraceable payment method to make a payment.
- ✓ Always check the ending of the sender's email address. This should match your utility company's website: @wyogas.com

RECIPE: Crockpot Hot Chocolate

- 6 cups whole milk
- 2 (12oz cans) evaporated milk
- 2 cups heavy cream
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 3 cups chocolate chips
- marshmallows or whip cream (optional)



Directions:

1. Mix all the ingredients together in a 6-quart crockpot. Cook on low for 2-3 hours, stirring often the first hour to make sure the chocolate incorporates and doesn't burn to the bottom.
