
## New Customer Web Portal Coming Soon!

Wyoming Gas Company is teaming up with Silverblaze to bring you a new online experience. This new web portal will allow customers to view and pay bills, view and compare historical consumption and bill data, and add multiple accounts to your web profile. You will also be able to complete and submit common forms such as the Move In Request, Move Out Request, and Information Change Request from the online portal.

This change is scheduled to take place on Tuesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, therefore, the customer web portal section of WGC's website will be down for most of the day. Additional information on down time or any delays in this schedule will be posted on WGC's website [www.wyogas.com](http://www.wyogas.com).

A sample of the new log in screen can be seen below. For all active customers, WGC will migrate your User Name from the old portal to the new portal. Due to current password encryption, WGC will NOT migrate any passwords to the new portal. All customers will need to use the 'Forgot your Password' link to reset their password and log in to the new portal. If your User Name is not moved to the new portal or you don't currently have an online account, please use the 'Sign Up Now' button to create a new online account.

The U.S. Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency offers these three tips for better password security –

A good password follows all three!

### 1. Make them long

Passwords should be at least 16 characters long. Remember, longer is stronger!

### 2. Make them random

Create a memorable phrase of five to seven unrelated words. Then, get creative with spelling and the addition of a number or symbol.

### 3. Make them unique

Do not use the same password for multiple accounts. Password manager software can help you keep up with these longer, more complex passwords.

Although natural gas is generally considered a heating fuel, it also has some cooler applications – like chilling the glycol used to produce ice for hockey and skating rinks.

**RECIPE: Chocolate Covered Strawberries**

- 16 ounces milk chocolate chips
- 2 Tablespoons shortening
- 1 pound fresh strawberries with leaves
- toothpicks (for dipping)



**Directions:**

1. Melt chocolate and shortening in a double boiler, stirring occasionally until smooth. You can also melt the chocolate and shortening in a microwave, stirring every 20 seconds, until mixture is smooth.
2. Insert toothpicks into tops (stem ends) of strawberries. Hold a strawberry by the toothpick and dip it into the chocolate mixture.
3. Turn strawberry upside down and insert the toothpick into a Styrofoam block or place strawberry on a sheet of waxed paper; allow chocolate coating to cool.
4. Repeat with remaining strawberries. Enjoy!
